-(.2.3) = draw 2 & 3 together

. = lower register (first four holes on 16 hole)

(-4) = play this note when the corresponding syllable is sung

Example: In the 1st verse, first line, play it.

In verses 2, 3 and 4, don't play it and instead hold the previous note.
